ELEMENTARY CODE OF CONDUCT

The goal of the Elementary Code of Conduct is to promote a positive, safe atmosphere for teaching, learning and mutual respect. It is the result of a combined effort of administration, parents, teachers, students and the Board of Education. In order to accomplish this goal, the entire school community must work cooperatively.

		Disciplinary consequences will be determined by the administration resulting from positive behavioral interventions to suspensions along with police notification.

ANY FEDERAL, STATE, OR MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS AND/OR POLICIES WILL SUPERCEDE DISTRICT POLICIES RELATIVE TO DISCIPLINARY ISSUES

Our West Deptford Elementary Schools shall endeavor to maintain the type of educational environment that every student is entitled to - one that is free from harassment or bullying, both physical and verbal. Harassment or bullying may take many forms. It can be in the nature of name calling, verbal abuse, continual pushing or shoving in the halls, or a threat of fighting. It may also take on sexual overtones. Sexual harassment consists of

any unwelcome sexual advances or other inappropriate verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature made by staff members or other students. Even minor harassment or an incident of bullying can eventually create serious problems. The staff at our district elementary schools will address and make every effort to resolve any incidents of harassment or bullying brought to our attention. Any student who believes he or she is a victim of harassment or bullying should report the allegations to a staff member, guidance counselor, or administrator as soon as possible.
